Essential Agile Processes Part 8: Risk Adjusted Backlog

Agile backlogs are about organizing the value that will be delivered to the customer as a result of a project. One important step in any project is to account for risks that could provide positive or negative impact on the key outcomes that provide value. Mike Griffiths, writing for ProjectManagement.com, calls risks the "anti-value" on an agile project because of their ability to hinder value delivery (Griffiths, 2011, 20 September). On a project, risk management means identifying, planning for, and monitoring for risks that threaten to derail the project's schedule, budget, or scope. In agile, the risks threatening the scope take on greater dimension, since the scope is flexible. Risks on agile projects


