A Tiered Approach to Implement the PMBOK® Guide

Last year, we conducted a [survey of over 60 project managers](#) and found that nearly 75 percent of respondents felt that project management is becoming more difficult (PM Survey, 2014). With the perceived difficulty of project management increasing, how do organizations decide what project management processes to execute on any given project? A common struggle is "finding the sweet spot," where the resources devoted to project management are enough to provide the greatest value toward successful project delivery but not so much that they needlessly consume resources and time. Essential Agile Processes Part 5: Sprint Capacity Planning Sheet

As we have seen in project management, resource allocation is a critical process. Even the best-planned projects can't be carried out if there are not enough people to do the project activities, or if they are too busy. The Agile methodology places high value in teams delivering working software at the end of each sprint, collaborating closely with the customer, and managing their own output. To accomplish these goals, the team needs to have an accurate and honest assessment of its own capability. Furthermore, the team needs to measure its capability based on reality and not ideal scenarios or guesses. Without this knowledge, the team is very likely to fall short of sprint goals, which can affect morale and credibility if repeated. | [Read More](#)







